RE: Violations of State Law NRS 295.056 and NRS 295.0575 and Request for Invalidation of "The Background Check Initiative"

Dear Secretary of State Miller,

This is a formal request to invalidate the ballot initiative entitled "The Background Check Initiative" because it did not comply with NRS 295.056 and NRS 295.0575. Specifically:

NRS 295.056.2 states: If a petition for initiative proposes a statute or an amendment to a statute, the document or documents <u>must be submitted not later than the second Tuesday in November</u> of an even-numbered year.

NRS 295.056.5 states: All documents which are submitted to a county clerk for verification must be submitted at the same time. If documents concerning the same petition are submitted for verification to more than one county clerk, the documents must be submitted to each county clerk on the same day.

Request for Invalidation: Per NRS 205.056.2, the deadline day was November 11, 2014. Because this was a National Holiday, the petitions were required to be submitted on November 12, statewide. According to the Storey County Clerk (please see attachments), these petitions were not delivered to Storey County until November 13. The petitioners failed to meet the requirements of state law for submission of petition signatures statewide. Since the requirements of state law were not met for all petition signatures to be filed with multiple counties on the same day, the statewide petition failed to meet minimal legal requirements and should be invalidated and not presented to the voters.

I, <u>Vanessa Stephens</u>, the duly appointed, qualified and acting County Clerk/Registrar of Voters of the County of <u>Storey</u>, State of Nevada, do hereby certify that the above entitled petition was submitted to my office on <u>November 13, 2014</u>; that the petition consists of <u>68</u> documents; that each document contains signatures

NRS 295.0575 states: <u>Each document of a petition must have attached to it when submitted an</u> affidavit executed by the circulator thereof stating:

- 1. That the circulator personally circulated the document.
- 2. The contact information of the circulator, including, without limitation, the street address of the residence where the circulator actually resides, unless a street address has not been assigned. If a street address has not been assigned, the document must contain the mailing address of the circulator.
 - 3. That the circulator is 18 years of age or older.

Request for Invalidation: Per NRS 295.0575, each document must have an affidavit attached to it. Of the 68 signature documents submitted to Storey County, only the last page has the affidavit. Please note that it indicates that it <u>verifies only one page, not 68 pages</u>. In addition it states that the affidavit was for "County of Washoe"

Request for Invalidation: The Affidavit of Circulator attached to the last one of the 68 pages is dated <u>25 October 2014</u>, yet petition signatures are dated after this date. The Affidavit was signed before signatures were obtained on at least 52 occasions. This is a false affidavit.

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We have presented documented proof that the State Laws for petition requirements were violated. Consequently, the ballot petition entitled "The Background Check Initiative" must be invalidated and not presented to the voters. We will inform you of other violations as they are discovered; however, we feel this is sufficient information to cause the invalidation of the petition.
